Welcome to the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme

There's lots of funded activities available for children and young people aged 5-16 years who attend an East Riding school in the summer holidays. Why not burn off some energy on our sports, dance, and football camps, or relax at our farm and craft experiences? You could also learn a new skill by taking part in outdoor adventure, cooking or storytelling workshops. Plus, there's glow sports, bocchia, caving and den building for pupils with SEND.

All HAF sessions are available for children and young people in receipt of benefits related free school meals who attend an East Riding school, and we also have a small number of places on all programmes for pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan. Your child can attend up to sixteen sessions for free during the summer holidays with a meal provided at each event.

All activities are located in one place, so sign up to eryc.link/HAFbookings and book your activities.

Parent and carers need to sign up to Plinth, the centralised booking system before bookings activities. There will be a range of sessions to choose from and parents can search via area, age group or type of activities.

All About HAF

How do I know if my child is eligible for free HAF activities?

Give us a call on ☎ (01482) 394799. All you'll need is your National Insurance number or registered asylum seekers number, and we will be able to check to see if your child is eligible for benefits related free school meals and able to attend sessions during the holidays.

My children are in Foundation, Year 1 and Year 2 and receive free school meals, can they book onto HAF?

Although all pupils receive universal free meals in foundation and primary education, HAF is only for those families in receipt of various benefits, including universal credit (with an income no more than £7,400) income support, etc. HAF is funded by the Department for Education who recognises that there are greater pressures for those families during the school holidays.

Do I have to book all sixteen sessions with the same provider?

No, your child may wish to attend the same provision (it might be close to where you live or they may enjoy a particular activity), but you can choose from all our programmes.

My child has special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), can they attend HAF sessions?

We have a small number of SEND specific providers who offer sessions just for your son or daughter, and the remaining organisations will have some staff that are experienced and trained to support pupils with SEND. They will be able to make reasonable adjustments to enable your child to access part or all of the provision where possible. To help the provider support your child, please email or give the provider a call, and remember to keep relevant information updated about your child's needs and disabilities on the registration form.

Will I be asked to stay with my child for part or all of the session?

Depending on the provider and the number of bookings they have, parents and carers may be asked to stay to see if the provision is suitable for your child or to help them enjoy the session. Please note that HAF sessions are not childcare and providers are not Care Quality Commission registered so are not able to provide personal care.

What if my child needs one-to-one support to access the HAF session?

The HAF programme is able to support a small number of children who have an EHCP and who receive one-to-one support in school. Firstly, please speak to the HAF provider about how they are able to support your child. If a one-to-one is required and if in receipt of Direct Payment support from East Riding Children's Social Care, parents should discuss this with their Social Worker or Family Co-ordinator. If parents are not in receipt of this support, please request a one-to-one application form from haf@eastriding.gov.uk. Any forms received after **Monday, 14 July** may not be processed in time. Please note that providers have the right to refuse participation if a one-to-one has not been secured or a family member is not able to stay at the session.

My children has an EHCP, can their brothers and sisters attend too?

Unfortunately, they do not qualify for a funded HAF place as determined by the Department for Education, however many providers are offering payable places as shown on the next page. These places may be bookable via Plinth, or the provider may be taking their own payable bookings. Don't forget to search for family activities via the local offer at eastridinglocaloffer.org.uk
