We are very impressed with how much the children know about Fair Trade and how many recognize the logo.



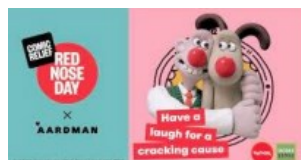
Red Nose Day
