# LOTTERY CLUB RULES

## PURPOSE

The purpose of the Lottery Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PTA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources, and opportunities for pupils.

## RULES

1. For a cost of £12 per year you will be allocated one number.
2. A draw will be made every month with a single cash prize.
3. The prizes will total 50% of the annual income.
4. The Lottery Club is a small society lottery registered with East Riding of Yorkshire Council and is open to all parents, carers, staff, and friends of Pollington School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
5. Payments must be made in cash, Bank Transfer or by cheque made payable to "Pollington HSA".
6. The draw shall be made at the end of each month.
7. If you have the winning number, you will be contacted by text or email within 1 week of the draw having taken place.
8. Your cash prize will be available for collection once you have received your text or email notification. If you wish to nominate someone to collect the prize on your behalf, you must do so by replying to your notification text or email confirming the name of the person authorised to collect your prize. CASH PRIZES CANNOT BE SENT HOME WITH CHILDREN!
9. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the Parent Council Facebook page.
10. The Lottery Club will be run by the PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
11. If a cash prize remains uncollected after 6 months, it will be deemed to have been donated to the PTA fund.
